



Connecting Shogo to Sage Intacct

In order for Shogo to access your Sage Intacct company's data, we need to set up a Web Services User Role and Web Services User and then gather some information from Sage Intacct including your Company ID.

Create Web Services Role




Create a special user in Sage Intacct called a Web Services user. This user cannot log in to your Sage Intacct account. Its purpose is to allow Shogo to access your data behind the scenes.

- 1. Go to Applications -> Company -> Roles
- 2. Click the [Add] button at the top right
- 3. Fill in the values as shown pictured and click [Save]




Create Web Services Role



- 4. From the Roles list, click [Edit] next to the Shogo WS Role, and click [View Subscriptions]
- 5. Click on each of the Permission sets except for Administration and choose [All] and click [Save]





- 5. Under the [Roles information] tab, select the Shogo WS Role you created earlier, and click [Save]




Register the Shogo Sender ID with Sage Intacct




- 1. Navigate to Applications -> Company -> Setup -> Company

- 3. Scroll down to [Web Services authorizations] and click [Add]
